



Scarborough Centre for Healthy Communities (SCHC) is one of the most established and comprehensive community health organizations in the province. The organization owes its beginnings to 13 community agencies, a core group of community leaders and countless volunteers who identified emerging health and social needs within Scarborough.

After incorporating and acquiring not-for-profit status in 1977, SCHC built on the initial services of our Meals-on-Wheels, home support, transportation and family support programs. We employ over 200 staff, engage over 650 volunteers and operate 38 distinct and integrated services across 11 sites that work together to improve the health and wellbeing of the diverse communities of Scarborough. Through a health equity lens, we provide medical assistance through our community health centres, community support services for seniors, are involved in a growing youth program and have a multitude of social support programs including food, furniture and clothing banks.

We do so by working closely with our community members and fostering partnerships with initiatives that address pressing needs while setting new standards of excellence.
