The Lawrence East Partnership Program (LEPP) is a collaborative community-based program. Using an inter-disciplinary model of care, LEPP offers residents of 4175 and 4205 Lawrence Ave East holistic supports and services. Our mandate is to connect community members with local resources and supports and help residents maintain successful tenancies within our buildings.

SERVICES

Our interdisciplinary team offers a variety of expertise to support our community members with their goals and needs.

Cota & Fred Victor Case Managers

- Offers goal setting and supportive counselling
- Promotes mental and emotional well-being

Housing Coordinator

- Helps with forms and advocacy related to housing
- Education about tenant rights/responsibilities

Registered Nurse

- Promotes physical well-being and provides health education
 - Offers blood pressure clinics, flu shots, etc.

Peer Support Outreach Worker

- Promotes wellness related to mental health and addictions
 - Provides social and recreational groups for residents

Independent Support Worker

- Coaches residents with independent life skills
- Assists in apartment readiness for pest treatment or repairs

Outreach Team

- Engages and supports Resident Engagement Advisors
- Facilitates outreach and delivers programs to residents
