FLU CLINIC INSTRUCTIONS

INSTRUCTIONS

Cars should enter the parking lot from the Eglinton Ave Entrance and exit onto Brimley.

Station One

Proceed to station one (staff will confirm registration and complete consent form).

Station Two

Client will proceed to station 2 for immunization with a nurse.

Station Three

Clients will proceed to station 3 for 15mins observation. Clients are advised to honk their horn continuously if they experience an adverse reaction or medical emergency.

PLEASE NOTE

- Registration is required, only those with an appointment time will receive the flu vaccine.
- All client will be prescreened for COVID-19 and will be asked to complete a consent form.
- Max of four clients per vehicle.-All clients must wear a mask and loose clothing with an arm easily accessible.

WE WILL NOT BE ABLE TO ADMINISTER TO THE FOLLOWING:

- Anyone with a fever or acute illness
- Anyone who experienced a serious reaction to past vaccination (Example: difficulty breathing, red eyes, facial swelling (Oculorespiratory syndrome))
- If you are allergic to the following: previous doses of influenza vaccine, egg/egg proteins, Formaldehyde, Triton X-100, Thimerosal
- If you are pregnant or breastfeeding
- If you were diagnosed with any of the following: Active neurological disorders, Guillain-Barre Syndrome, Bleeding disorders e.g. Haemophilia
- If you are currently taking blood thinners (Not including aspirin)
- Any child between the age of 6 months and 9 years AND you have never received a flu shot before
- Drivers receiving the vaccine for the first time
- Driver with a history of syncope (dizziness)
