PROGRAM INFORMATION

Scarborough Centre for Healthy Communities' Housing Help program assists individuals and families who are homeless or are facing eviction to arrange for more secure housing through a range of services including advocacy, education, referral for access to resource programs, and income supports.

All SCHC referrals to the Scarborough Furniture Bank (SFB) are made by the Homelessness Intervention Coordinator after suitability is determined. Other SCHC staff members can direct their referrals to the Homelessness Intervention Coordinator
