Purpose:

The Physician will provide comprehensive primary health care for individuals and families living in the Scarborough community with an emphasis on service delivery for marginalized and at risk community members.

Key areas of responsibility:

- Provide comprehensive family centered primary health care services within his/her full scope of practice
- Adhere to standards of best practice
- Actively participate within an inter-professional model of care
- Willingness to participate in Health Centre health promotion/outreach initiatives
- Participate in case conferences as required
- Capacity to work in team setting delivering services to marginalized individuals living with chronic illness
- Perform other duties as assigned that are reasonable within the scope of the job.

Scope and Accountability

The Physician will function within their full scope of practice in accordance to College standards. The Physician is accountable to the agencies program Vice President/Manager.

Educational and/or Professional Qualifications:

- Graduate medical degree from a recognized university
- Registration and in good standing with the Ontario College of Physicians and Surgeons
- Registration with CMPA
- CCFP Certification or equivalent practical experience
- Willingness to maintain CME credentials as required.

- 3-5 years medical practice in an inter-professional /CHC/FHT model of care considered an asset.
- Willingness to work within a collaborative model of care.
